### <u>Fall Judging Meet, Technical Seminar,</u> and General Business Meeting

**November 17-18 Meeting Minutes** 

On Sunday, November 18, the Chapter held its Fall Judging Meet at Darrell Suber's home in Long Beach, Mississippi. Approximately twenty two (24) chapter members attended this event. The following cars were judged and awards presented:

A short Judging School was conducted by Ralph Adams prior to the start of judging on Sunday morning.

The prior evening (Saturday November 17) a Judging School and a Technical Seminar were both held at the Holiday Inn in Gulfport, Mississippi as part of the overall weekend event. The Judging School was conducted by Chapter Judging Chairman Darrell Suber and was on OPERATIONS JUDGING. The Technical Seminar was presented by Larry Mulder and was on ENGINE BELLHOUSING ALIGNMENT. Each session lasted approximately 45 minutes. Approximately twelve (12) chapter members attended these presentations.

After judging and the awards presentation on Sunday afternoon, the chapter held a general business meeting to review planning for the September 2013 Regional and to elect officers for next year.

Ralph Adams provided an update of our 2013 Regional Planning. The event is being called the NEW ORLEANS DEEP SOUTH REGIONAL. It will be held at the Kenner Pontchartrain Convention Center on September 19 thru September 22 (Thursday thru Sunday). The

contract for the convention center has been signed and includes a fifty percent down payment. The adjacent Hilton Gardens Hotel (now called the Kenner Hotel New Orleans Airport) will be the host hotel for the

event. This hotel has 122 rooms. Ralph also has two overflow hotels available nearby if needed. *A Louisiana-style Shrimp Boil* is being planned to kick off the event on Thursday night before the Regional.

The event will be open to the General Public on Friday and Saturday with an entry fee to help reduce overall event costs.

We are also looking at putting together a Road Trip to the Jackson (Mississippi) Corvette Show during the summer, and judging one car at this show to promote NCRS and our Louisiana Chapter. It will be an indoor event. Mike Martin will try to get an invitation for our chapter to see a large personal Corvette/car collection that is in the area. We will continue to update progress on this event.

Additional activities and dates will be communicated when they are known. Call or email Mike Leeds with any of your suggestions or input. Also check the chapter website for information.

We also need someone to put together a Technical Seminar next year on something Corvette or general automotive related. This is needed each year to achieve the Chapter TOP FLIGHT Award. Thus far Gary Cox, Bill Folse, and Larry Mulder (2) have led these tech seminars. Contact Larry or Mike Leeds if you have any ideas for a seminar, or you can lead this activity for 2013.

The meeting was adjourned at approximately 5 pm.

### 2013 NCRS Chapter Award Program

The NCRS Chapter Award Program was developed to promote involvement and participation by members in their chapter events while encouraging the sharing of knowledge in the restoration and preservation of the Corvette. The program measures the performance of each chapter against standard award criteria similar to the principal used in NCRS judging. Each chapter is eligible to receive an award every year after submitting the required quarterly reports and fulfilling the required criteria

The Award Program is based on the calendar year January 1 to December 31. Recognition Certificates are issued in February, and the award is presented to the chapter at the National Convention

### **Required Activities** for the year

- 1R Host a Chapter Judging Meet
- 2R Conduct a Chapter Technical Seminar
- 3R Conduct a Chapter Judging School
- 4R Conduct a Chapter Membership Meeting
- 5R Conduct a Chapter Charitable Event (does not have to be Corvette related)
- 6R Conduct a Chapter Road Tour
- 7R Have a Chapter Social Event
- 8R Maintain a Chapter Website linked to www.ncrs.org

### Variable Activities for the year

- 1V Judging Meet must include cars registered for Flight Judging from at least 5% of the chapter membership
- 2V Six technical articles must be published in the Chapter Newsletter
- 3V A total of 15% or more of the chapter members and/or family members must judge or tabulate at the Judging Meet(s). Each person can only be counted once during the year.
- 4V At least 15% of Chapter members must drive their Corvette(s) to a Chapter Meeting or Chapter Event during the year. The Chapter Road Tour is not included. Each person can only be counted once during the year.
- 5V Chapter Road Tour must include at least 5% of the members cars.
- 6V At least 20% of the chapter members must attend one or more Chapter Meetings or Events.
- 7V Set Up NCRS Display at a Non-NCRS Car Event.
- 8V A charitable donation of \$100 or more is donated to a 501-3C qualified charity

Quarterly Reporting: Quarterly reports are due April 10, July 10, October 10, and January 10. Reports received after the deadline will result in all activities during that quarter being disallowed. Supporting documentation including Chapter Newsletters and Chapter Meeting Sign-in Sheets must accompany each quarterly report. The reports are to be sent to Arland Dower.
