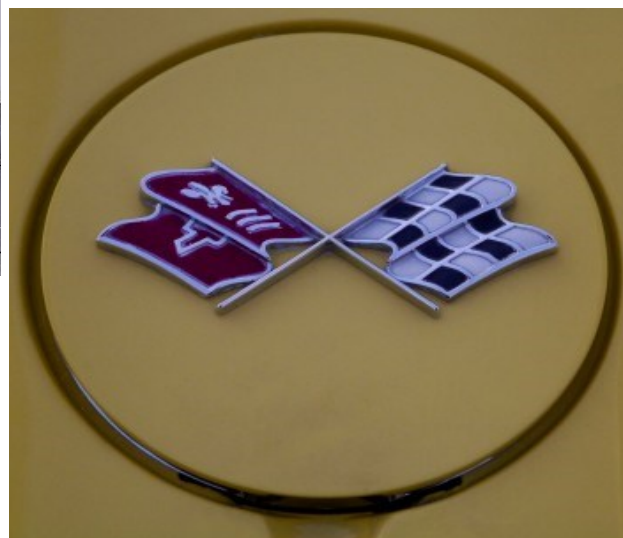

From Slidell head West on I-12 and exit at 63A. Follow same directions to get to Pear Street.

NCRS Heartland Regional 2021– Cedar Rapids, Iowa By Cindy & Maxie Rodriguez

So, what do you do when you have a few days off and looking for something to do? How about drive 1,000 miles one way to Cedar Rapids, Iowa to judge Corvettes. That's what we did.

Haven't been on a driving trip in a while, since Covid became reality, but it sure felt great and most of the country was unmasked and happy about it too. We drove to St. Louis the first night and had a great meal, great bed, and relaxing time. Next morning up bright and early and finished our trip into Iowa. This was a new area for us since we have not attended any regionals in this state but nice scenery and light traffic in this part of the country. The Regional was held at the Hawkeye Downs Speedway where they let cars autocross on the track and take pictures on the track as well. The judging was indoors, which helped since Iowa was as hot as Louisiana when we got there.

Since Covid affected NCRS Regionals and cancelled the Convention in French Lick last year, many of the car owners were lacking in their pre-requisites for the 2021 Convention in Palm Springs so NCRS planned a mini meet for two days prior to the regional to hold PV's. They had 18 PV cars to do. Once the mini meet was over, the owners had to Flight Judge their cars at the Regional as well, this way they had two separate events for their cars to fulfill requirements. They did the same thing at the AZ meet and it was successful also. This is a one-time thing due to Covid so don't look for it in the future.

As Maxie judged 67 interiors again, I networked with Team Leaders and Chapter members from around the country to promote our New Orleans Regional. Most were very receptive and glad we stepped up to do this, since they have been wanting to come back to New Orleans ever since they left in 2013 after that regional. Needless to say, I answered lots of questions about our bus trip to the french quarter and food questions and masking questions and everything was well received. I learned a lot from the way they conducted their regional and that was my goal, to pick their brains too. Special thanks to Don Heckenberg, Judging Chairman, for the knowledge he imparted.

They had over 50 Flight judged cars including PVs and several specialty Corvettes including not one but two 53's. Largest group for judging was 67's with 11 cars, including one from our own chapter. Several of our chapter members from outside LA were there. Maxie had a hard two days on his knees but recovered enough to drive that 1,000 miles back home. On our way home we stopped to visit Mike Martin in MS at his restoration shop. Nice place to see a variety of projects underway. He still wants us to make a club trip to his place for a judging meet. Maybe we can get that done before too long. The trip was tough but we made it and was glad to be home with memories to last. My best memory is seeing everyone together again and excited that NCRS is going full speed ahead and it takes members showing up to make each event a success.



NCRS Chapter Award Program

The NCRS Chapter Award Program was developed to promote involvement and participation by members in their chapter events while encouraging the sharing of knowledge in the restoration and preservation of the Corvette. The program measures the performance of each chapter against standard award criteria similar to the principal used in NCRS judging. Each chapter is eligible to receive an award every year after submitting the required quarterly reports and fulfilling the required criteria. The Award Program is based on the calendar year January 1 to December 31. Recognition Certificates are issued in February, and the award is presented to the

- **4V** A total of 15% of Chapter members must drive their Corvette(s) to a Chapter meeting or Chapter event during the year. The Chapter Road Tour is not included. Each person can only be counted once during the year
- **5V** Chapter Road Tour must include at least 5% of the members cars
- **6V** At least 20% of the Chapter members must attend one or more Chapter meetings or events
- **7V** Set up NCRS display at a Non-NCRS event
- **8V** A charitable donation of \$100 or more is donated to a 501-3C qualified charity
