Theresa McCoy's Delicious Recipes

JAMBALAYA GRITS (Serves 12-16)

1 Tbsp olive oil
 1 stick of butter
 1 bag of frozen onion, bell pepper, and celery
 1 ½ tsp salt
 ¼ tsp black pepper
 ½ tsp cayenne
 1 pkg smoked sausage, sliced, cubed
 ½ lb cooked ham, cubed
 1 Tbsp chopped garlic
 1 can of Mild Rotel Tomatoes
 5 cups milk
 2 cups old fashioned grits
 1 lb white cheddar cheese, grated
 1 8 oz cream cheese, softened
 Green Onions, diced for topping

Heat olive oil and butter in large pot on stove. Sauté bag of onions, bell pepper, and celery along with salt, cayenne, and black pepper. Once veggies are soft, toss in smoked sausage and ham, let cook for a couple of minutes. Add Rotel and garlic.

Add milk and bring to a boil, reduce heat and stir in grits. Let this cook a couple minutes, add diced ham and continue to stir occasionally until grits are tender and creamy, about twenty minutes. Before serving, add cream cheese and white cheddar cheese. Once all is melted, top with green onions.

LEMON FANTASY Serves 20

First Layer:

1 ½ cup flour
 1 cup chopped pecans
 1 stick butter, softened

Mix and press into 9 x 13 pan. Bake 20-25 minutes at 350 degrees.

Second Layer:

12 oz cream cheese, softened
 1 cup powdered sugar
 8 oz cool whip

Mix cream cheese and powdered sugar until well blended. Add cool whip and spread mixture over cooled first layer. Chill for 30 minutes to 1 hour.

Third Layer:

2 cans condensed milk
 1 egg plus 1 yolk
 1 cup lemon juice

Mix until well blended and spread over second layer. Top with 8 oz cool whip. Chill and serve.

Optional: Sprinkle with chopped pecans

NCRS Chapter Award Program

The NCRS Chapter Award Program was developed to promote involvement and participation by members in their chapter events while encouraging the sharing of knowledge in the restoration and preservation of the Corvette. The program measures the performance of each chapter against standard award criteria similar to the principal used in NCRS judging. Each chapter is eligible to receive an award every year after submitting the required quarterly reports and fulfilling the required criteria. The Award Program is based on the calendar year January 1 to December 31. Recognition Certificates are issued in February, and the award is presented to the

Required Activities for the year

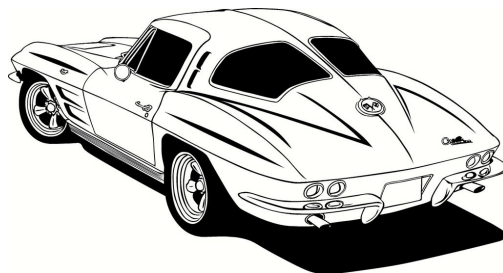
- **1R** Host a Chapter Judging Meet
- **2R** Conduct a Chapter Technical Seminar
- **3R** Conduct a Chapter Judging School
- **4R** Conduct a Chapter Membership Meeting
- **5R** Conduct a Chapter Charitable Event (does not have to be Corvette related)
- **6R** Conduct a Chapter Road Tour
- **7R** Have a Chapter Social Event
- **8R** Maintain a Chapter Website linked to www.ncrs.org

Variable Activities for the year

- **1V** Judging Meet must include cars registered for Flight Judging from at least 5% of the Chapter membership
- **2V** Six technical articles must be published in the Chapter Newsletter
- **3V** A total of 15% or more of the Chapter members and/or family members must judge or tabulate at the Judging Meet(s). Each person can only be counted once during the year
- **4V** A total of 15% of Chapter members must drive their Corvette(s) to a Chapter meeting or Chapter event during the year. The Chapter Road Tour is not included. Each person can only be counted once during the year
- **5V** Chapter Road Tour must include at least 5% of the members cars
- **6V** At least 20% of the Chapter members must attend one or more Chapter meetings or events
- **7V** Set up NCRS display at a Non-NCRS event
- **8V** A charitable donation of \$100 or more is donated to a 501-3C qualified charity
