Is the "Pan-dammit" Over Yet? By John Maggiore

I don't know about you, but I need to get out and drive to a car event. The local car club in Hammond finally started up their monthly cruise nights in March. Unfortunately, I was too busy with work, so my plan was to get the '63 coupe ready for the April event.

But, before I get into that, let me say the last time the car was out of the shop was in October for Cruising the Coast. Unlike all the past years, Dale and I didn't stay in Gulfport or Biloxi. She and I drove her 1966 pickup to registration on Wednesday, and spent the day relaxing at Cruise-In-Central, and drove back home Wednesday evening. On Thursday morning my son Nathan and I drove the '63 to all six venues, had a great time, but again returned to Hammond in the evening. It was great to finally get out and enjoy the car. But, unbeknownst to me, the power steering pump was about to fail. The following week, I backed the car out of the shop, and the pump was DOA. No big deal, just change it, right. Wrong! Building a rest-o-mod, in my opinion, is easier than restoring a Corvette for flight judging. Need parts, just pull out a Summit Racing catalog, and start shopping. My serpentine belt system came from Vintage Air. Easy, call Vintage Air and ask, what power steering pump do they use. No not easy, the parts person had no idea. They outsource to Detroit Speed. When you call Detroit Speed, they won't tell you, but they will be happy to sell you a new pump. OK, buy a new pump and change it out. Problem fixed!

Now back to the April Hammond cruise night. A week before the planned cruise night, I pull the cover off the '63, and take it for a ride. Wait, I hear a strange noise. Remember building a rest-o-mod is easier than building a Corvette for flight judging, just pull out a Summit Racing catalog, and start shopping. I couldn't just put power steering in the car, no, I had to be exotic and put "electric" power steering in the car. Well, the electric pump that supplies the boost to the master cylinder was DOA. It was running, and supplying boost to the master cylinder, but the damn thing wouldn't stop running. Come to find out, the pressure switch is looking for 2,000 psi, but mine was falling short of the goal. Well, Dale and I did make the April Hammond cruise night, she in her '66 pickup, and me not in the '63. Hopefully the new replacement pump will be in soon. Who knows, the '63 may be ready for the May cruise night.



NCRS Chapter Award Program

The NCRS Chapter Award Program was developed to promote involvement and participation by members in their chapter events while encouraging the sharing of knowledge in the restoration and preservation of the Corvette. The program measures the performance of each chapter against standard award criteria similar to the principal used in NCRS judging. Each chapter is eligible to receive an award every year after submitting the required quarterly reports and fulfilling the required criteria. The Award Program is based on the calendar year January 1 to December 31. Recognition Certificates are issued in February, and the award is presented to the
